

## Frequently Asked Questions Regarding HEERF II Student Emergency Grant Funds

**Q: Do I need to apply in order to receive my HEERF II Grant?**

**A:** No. There is no application process in order for students to receive their HEERF II funds. Awards will be distributed to all eligible students, as determined by the Institution.

**Q: How do I know if I'm eligible to receive HEERF II funds?**

**A:** Students who are/were enrolled with a status of active, probation, or leave of absence as of May 31, 2021 are eligible to receive HEERF II Student Grant funds.

**Q: Why am I receiving this grant?**

**A:** The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II is authorized by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA Act), Public Law 116-260. On December 27, 2020, the CRRSAA Act was signed into law giving the U.S. Department of Education approximately \$22.7 billion for the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF II). Of this amount, over \$680 million was made available for proprietary institutions of higher education to provide financial aid grants to students.

**Q: What are the HEERF II funds for?**

**A:** Federal regulations state that HEERF II financial aid grants for students may be used for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to the coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care) or child care.

**Q: If I'm eligible, how much will I receive?**

**A:** Award amounts are based on each student's Federal Pell grant eligibility status and enrollment status as shown in the tables below.

<b>Full-time enrolled students</b>	Pell eligible	\$ 1,788.00
	Non-Pell eligible	\$ 1,192.00

<b>Part-time enrolled students</b>	Pell eligible	\$ 1,192.00
	Non-Pell eligible	\$ 596.00

**Q: Does receipt of this grant affect my financial aid eligibility.**

**A:** No. HEERF II funds are not considered federal financial aid and do not affect a student's current or future eligibility for federal financial aid.

**Q: How will I receive my funds?**

**A:** Students attending on-campus classes will be contacted to pick up their checks in-person from the Financial Aid office. All other students (on externship or exclusively distance ed) will have their checks mailed

to the current address on file with the school. Students should email [heerf@glit.edu](mailto:heerf@glit.edu) to update or confirm their address information, if needed.

**Q: Can I use this grant to make payment on my tuition account?**

**A:** Yes. If you wish for your HEERF II funds to be applied directly to your tuition account you can email your written request to [heerf@glit.edu](mailto:heerf@glit.edu). If you have already received your HEERF II award and you wish to apply the funds to their tuition account you can simply cash your HEERF II check and a make payment directly to the school.
